Dear Parents and Community Members,

This is a very exciting time for Sherman Central School. Not only do our academic rankings support the hard work we are doing in the classroom, our students are performing at the state championship level on the field of play and in the arts and music. Sherman is thriving! The administration, faculty, and staff are dedicated to providing the very best education while ensuring Sherman opens every opportunity for our kids to succeed in any endeavor of their choosing.

You may have read that Sherman is proposing an aggressive capital building project that will solidify our space as one of the elite district's in the region for years to come. While part of the project addresses building maintenance issues and security concerns, the other part calls for the construction of a new gymnasium and two new classrooms. The gymnasium will allow us to open our master schedule to meet physical education requirements; offer new electives in emerging fields; provide student athletes with an additional practice facility so they can be home at a reasonable hour; and provide the community with a new space for health, wellness, and recreation.
